



# Snowshoe for Peace Sangha Day and Fundraiser

## Participant Notes

### How to participate

- Tell a Center manager that you plan to participate (Nick at KMC-Co, Thaye at HBC)
- If you would like to help us fundraise, then you can collect sponsorships using the provided sheet. The more the better. Let's make this a great fundraiser! This is a super way for your friends to create some good karma with meditation and Buddhism.
- Reserve snowshoes at a local store (or from friend, etc.). Poles are optional, maybe helpful.
- Pack a lunch and 2L of water in a backpack. Gloves, hat, scarf, windbreaker and sunscreen. Snow pants highly recommended (then you feel impervious to the snow, and a garbage bag to go sledding on makes it extra fun). It won't be overly strenuous, but it is the Colorado mountains, we need to be prepared.
- Arrange to carpool to the Estes Park Visitor Center at 10am, Saturday, February 2. Starbucks and McDonald's are across the street from the visitor center. That means leaving KMC-Co at 8:30am, or leaving Heruka Center at 9am.
- From there, we will drive to the Bear Lake Trailhead, and we plan to hike to Emerald Lake.

### Costs

Each person is responsible for their own snowshoes.

Each car must pay entry to Rocky Mountain National Park (\$25 unless someone has a pass).

### How to collect sponsorships

It's fun to tell people they can sponsor you per-vertical-foot. We'll climb 700 feet, so a \$0.01 sponsorship amounts to \$7. They may rib you about what happens if you don't make it all the way. But in practice people tend to just give a set amount, like \$25, \$100, or really any number.

Most people will probably just want to give their money up front, and this makes it easier, rather than having to ask them afterward. They can give cash, check, or donate with credit card / PayPal.
